Reapportionment Commission Votes to Change District Boundaries

As part of the mandatory every 10-year reapportionment, many legislative district boundaries are changing. **The new lines are changing as a result of population changes.**

The new district boundaries will take effect once the changes are certified by the court. For example, my legislative district's population has decreased over the past 10 years by about 8,000. Therefore, in order to ensure that each state representative in Pennsylvania is representing approximately 65,000 residents, the district boundaries must shift.

While I was hoping to retain the same neighborhoods I have been representing for the past three years, understanding I would have to pick up some new neighborhoods, I did not have a seat at the crafting table. I am disappointed to lose so many great neighborhoods that I have represented for the past three years. The

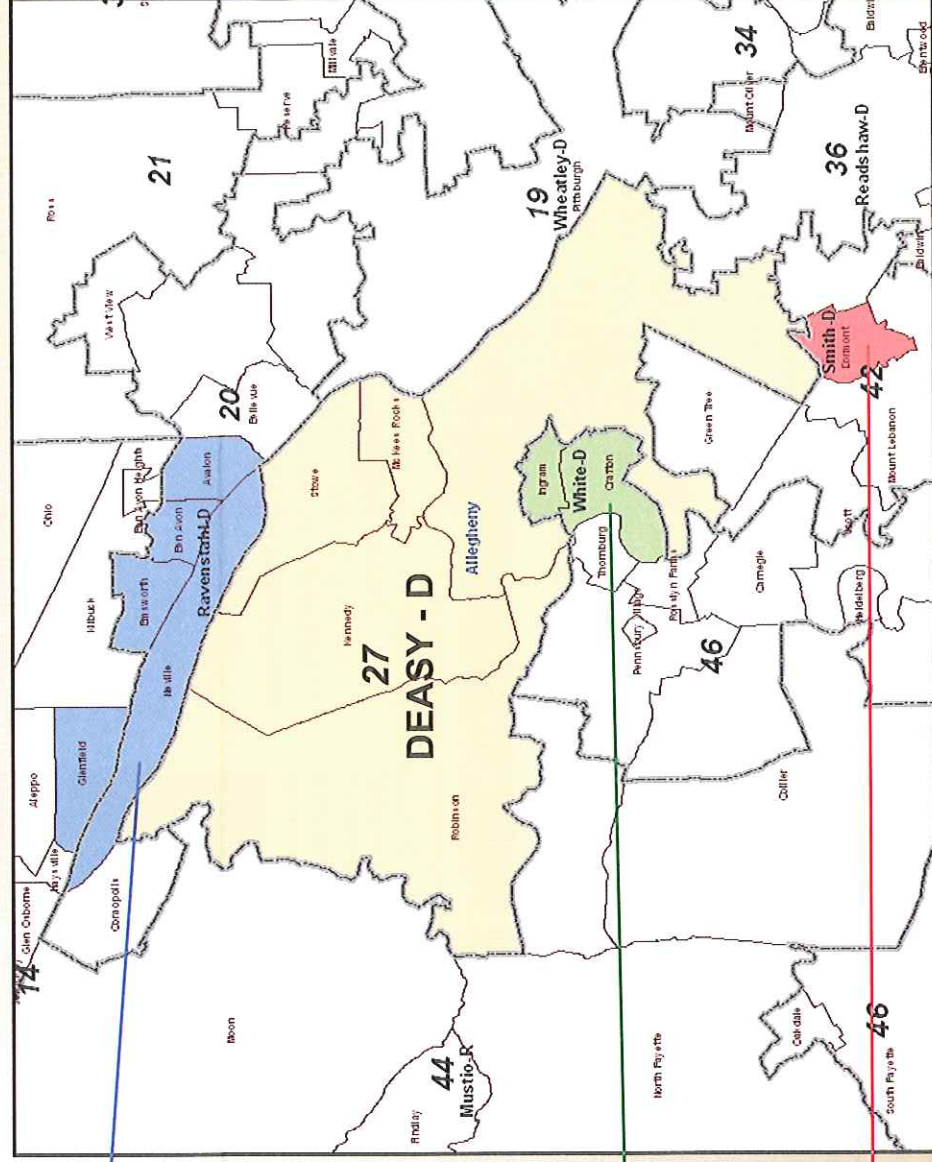
boroughs of Avalon, Emsworth, Ben Avon, Glenfield, and the township of Neville Island will shift to the 20th state house district, currently represented by Rep. Adam Ravenstahl. The borough of Dormont got shifted in the 42nd Legislative District, currently represented by Rep. Matt Smith. And, the boroughs of Crafton and Ingram were shifted into the 46th District, currently represented by Rep. Jesse White.

I look forward to and will do my best in representing the new constituents in my district. **The new district map has me representing 14 precincts (Mt. Washington & part of Beechview) in the 19th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh, all of the 20th & 28th Wards of the City of Pittsburgh, all of McKees Rocks Borough, all of Kennedy & Stowe Townships and part of Robinson Township, which includes precinct numbers 2,3,4,5,6,7 & 9.**
